This inaugural voyage is in memory of Colin Laidlaw, a man who had a passion for sailing and died after a short illness in 2017. Colin didn't just enjoy experiencing new destinations while sailing but meeting the challenge of each journey and all that the seas threw at him. Colin's family & friends have been doing an amazing job at fundraising in his memory and this fantastic effort has created this voyage to help enable others to experience what Colin did and get the most out of life.

The idea behind this voyage is to help young people develop a passion for sailing but also give them the opportunity to experience the excitement of being at sea and learn new skills. 8 deserving young people will be able to have this opportunity in 2018 and can apply for a place. This voyage will also include stepping ashore onto the magical Lundy Island*, where we are often met by puffins, seals and dolphins.

The voyage will be almost fully funded, with each individual contributing £25 towards their berth plus their travel costs to and from the boat. All food, refreshments, waterproofs, onboard accommodation, lifejackets provided. No prior sailing experience required.
