

Single Minded | Pioneer 10 - Being sold as seen

An opportunity to purchase a Pioneer 10 (Classic Boat). Originally purchased from Southern Ocean Shipyard in 1973, the Pioneer 10 was expertly fitted out by its original owner who eventually launched it in 1999. It boasts an interior woodwork that is to a higher standard than equivalent production boats. The seats and cockpit floor have been formed with a contoured shape that gives comfort and security at sea. Since it was launched in 1999 it had been lightly used before Challenge Wales took ownership where she was sailed just a few times. With TLC this will be a fantastic boat to own.

The charity Challenge Wales is now selling its training boat 'Single Minded'. 100% of the funds raised through selling the boat will go directly to the Challenge Wales sail training charity, providing transformative, innovative outdoor education and learning opportunities at sea to young people.

The Pioneer 10 has a hand laid GRP hull and deck with bonded in Bruynaeeel Marine plywood bulkheads and a moulded head lining. The main bulkhead stiffened with two overhead beams, takes the loads from the mast. The cast iron keel was sheathed in fibre glass, secured to the hull on stainless steel studs through fibre glass covered hard wood bearers

### **Accommodation:**

The generous beam gives plenty of room below deck for a small boat. Two berths in the forecabin with stowage under the berths, forward and to each side. There is a bi-fold door to separate the fore cabin from the heads.

Heads – Walk through heads with a Blakes Lavac toilet to port and generous hanging locker to starboard. Above the toilet is a slide out stainless steel sink.

The saloon offers two settee berths. The water tank is below the berths plus more storage. There are lockers each side above the berths for more storage.

The saloon table has ample room for four people.

Access to the Engine is by removal of the companionway steps.

The galley area is at the aft end of the saloon where there is adequate ventilation through the main entrance hatch. There is a 2 burner gas stove, mounted on gimbals, and sink.

Above the cooker is a stainless steel heat deflector, and below is a locker for pots and pans and cutlery drawer.

Galley has stainless steel sink and a deep ice box with drainage to bilges. Fresh water supplied with a foot operated pump

Quarter Berth: Extends back from Chart Table.

### **Sails**

Sails consist of a main, genoa, working jib, storm jib and spinnaker

All running rigging is present including sheets and guys for the spinnaker (some cordage has not been used)

2 solar panels

6 Lewmar winches

### **Navigation Equipment:**

Hasn't been recently used but includes GPS chart plotter, Clipper Echo Sounder, Compass.

### **Engine:**

A new engine is onboard Singleminded but has yet to be fitted. Some of the new parts are already purchased while some remaining parts will need to be purchased. Additional spend to get complete the engine project, based on previous estimates would be around £700 - £1,000. This is reflected in the price.
